

## Town of Robbinsville

March 8th, 2023

### Special Meeting

Members Present: Mayor Shaun Adams, Alderman Kenneth Hyde and Alderwoman Debbie Beasley,

Others Present: Lamar Williams, Hubert Merchant and town attorney Ellen Davis

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Shaun Adams at 1:00 p.m.

Kenneth Hyde motioned to amend agenda to move budget amendment to 1 under old business. Debbie Beasley 2<sup>nd</sup>. Vote unanimous

Mayor Adams opened floor to public comment at 1:07 p.m.

Hubert Merchant discussed his interest and qualifications in being appointed as alderman in the seat vacated by Brian Johnson during public comment.'

Board closed public comment at 1:14 after motion was made by Kenneth Hyde and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Debbie Beasley.

#### **Old Business:**

Becky Garland discussed budget amendments and were approved by a motion made by Debbie Beasley, Kenneth Hyde 2<sup>nd</sup>. Vote unanimous

Town hall appraisal: Mayor mentioned he filed the paperwork to appeal the tax value of the old town hall.

Town benches/homeless ordinance: Attorney Ellen Davis presented a proposed ordinance to the town and Kenneth Hyde made a motion to have a public hearing on the ordinance in the April 2023 regular meeting, and to publish it twice in the Graham Star, Debbie Beasley 2<sup>nd</sup>.

Town approved Cintas Contract after Debbie made the motion and Kenneth 2<sup>nd</sup>.

Town Attorney Ellen Davis Addressed Karen Lail's request for a right-of-way to the Long Creek tank on Grindstaff property and stated "If we don't own underlying land, we can't give a right-of-way"

#### **New Business:**

During the mayor update Mayor Adams mentioned American Tank Maintenance had only performed visual inspections of the tanks and no other work to them during the last year, but they received \$25,000 from the town and that money was not in budget.

Joel Storrow addressed the town about the storm water grant and water system asset inventory and assessment report.


The town approved the water system asset inventory and assessment report by a motion made by Debbie Beasley and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kenneth Hyde.


The board unanimously approved designating Kenneth Hyde and Debbie Beasley as Signatories on any financial or compliance documents related to CDBG grant 21-I-4002
