

**Town of Robbinsville**  
**Budget Public Hearing & Board Meeting Minutes**

A Regular Town of Robbinsville Board Meeting was called to order by Mayor Steve Hooper at 1:00 PM at the Town Hall on June 2, 2021.

Brian Johnson made a motion to approve the agenda. Shaun Adams seconded the motion. Vote unanimous.

**Approval of meeting minutes:**

Brian Johnson made a motion to approve the May 6, 2021 Special Board meeting minutes. Debbie Beasley seconded. Vote unanimous.

**Public Hearing – Proposed 2021-2022 Budget:**

The Finance Director stated that the May 2021 tax collection rate is 97.13%.

**National Opioid Settlement:**

Debbie Beasley made a motion for the Mayor to sign the Memorandum of Agreement for the Resolution by Graham County for the Settlement of Opioid Litigation presented by Graham County Finance Director, Becky Garland. Shaun Adams seconded the motion. Vote unanimous.

**Golf Cart Tags:**

Brian Johnson stated that the Board will do more research on this request.

**Hometown Tax – water pressure issue:**

The Mayor stated that this is on the Maintenance Supervisor’s list to do, but he will not make any promises of when the work will be completed.

**Road Improvement Quotes:**

Brian Johnson requested additional quotes.

**Customer – 3<sup>rd</sup> Leak Credit:**

Shaun Adams made a motion to approve the third leak credit for Susan Farley for \$629.09. Brian Johnson seconded the motion. Vote unanimous.

**Emergency Food Pantry Request:**

Debbie Beasley made a motion to approve \$2,000 support for the Emergency Food Pantry. Brian Johnson seconded the motion. Vote unanimous.

**Approval 2021-2022 Budget:**

Brian Johnson made a motion to approve the 2021-2022 Budget. Debbie Beasley seconded the motion. Vote unanimous.

**Water & Sewer Shut-off and Late Fees – Amendment to Ordinance:**

Brian Johnson made a motion to approve the Water & Sewer Shut-off and Late Fees Amendment to Municipality Owned Utilities Ordinance, Chapter 6 – Section 13 of the Code of Ordinances. Debbie Beasley seconded the motion. Motion passed 2-1. Shaun Adams opposed.

**Old Town Equipment Bids:**

Brian Johnson asked the Finance Director to post request for bids for the old Backhoes, old Fire Truck, exercise bike, old printers, computer miscellaneous, and TV’s once the Town has received the new Trackhoe.

**New Employee – sick hours from previous employer:**

Debbie Beasley made a motion to approve 65.48 sick leave carryover hours for new employee, Chris Williams, which he had accumulated during his employment with Graham County. Brian Johnson seconded the motion. Vote unanimous.

**American Rescue Plan Funds:**

Shaun Adams made a motion to accept the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 grant funds. Debbie Beasley seconded the motion. Vote unanimous.


**Town Hall – Terminix Proposal:**


**Snowbird Women Mural Reveal Presentation Support :**


Brian Johnson made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 2:15 PM. Debbie Beasley seconded the motion. Motion passed.


